Dear Art Instructor,

Please consider submitting senior art portfolios to the 32nd annual Scholarship Competition of the St. James Court Art Show, in fall 2010. Artist submissions are due on Tuesday, September 21 to The Weber Gallery in the Duval Center at 1151 South Fourth Street. The Weber Gallery is an excellent art venue with hanging systems and superb lighting. The gallery will nicely showcase student artwork for our professional jury.

We will once again award scholarships for two-dimensional painting and mixed media, printmaking, photography and watercolor- a total of nine scholarship grants worth more than \$19,000. The winners will exhibit at the Art Show on October 1, 2 & 3.

As you know, the visual arts teachers from Metro Louisville and surrounding counties are the referral source for student portfolios. Last year we were pleased to award two scholarships to two Indiana public high school seniors. We are gratified that our outreach efforts have gleaned portfolios from many schools in Metro Louisville.

In order to reach students who do not have the advantage of school-based visual arts programs, we once again invite teachers from the Louisville Visual Art Association (LVAA) to submit portfolios for high school seniors in their Children's Free Art classes.

The money raised at the art show maintains and improves much of historic Old Louisville. Proceeds maintain grassy medians, fountains, community gardens and common property. In recognition of community support for the art show, Old Louisville neighborhoods actively contribute to the community. The Scholarship Competition is one way in which neighborhoods that benefit from the Art Show express our gratitude, through support to emerging local artists.

Even if plans for fall 2010 are not your first priority, I encourage you to peruse the attached submission guidelines. We have made some changes since last year that might affect your planning.
